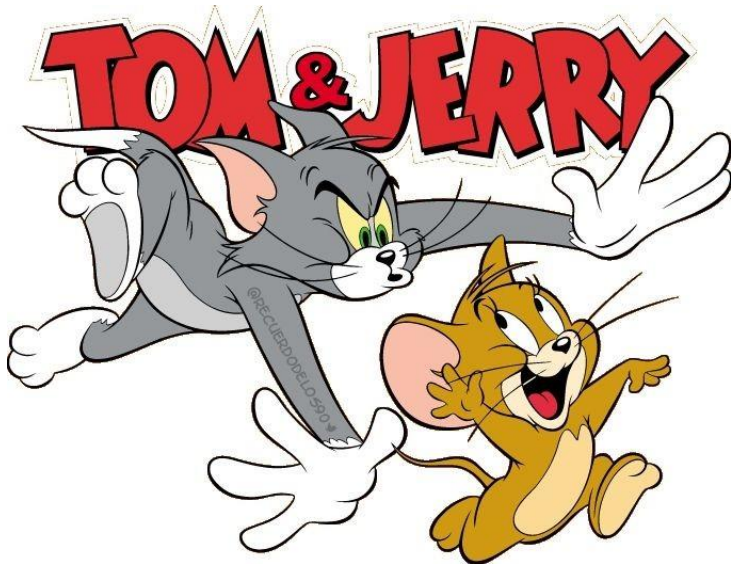

Imagine a hare

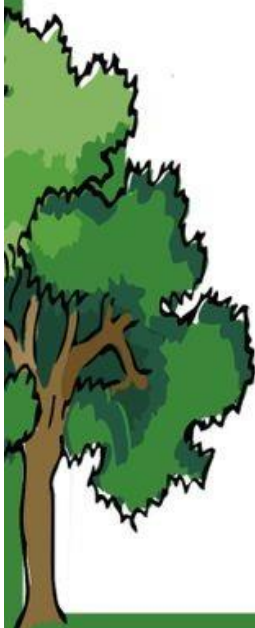
As big as a chair,
